We were able to donate another 10 quilts to SCH Oncology which brings us up to 28 quilts to oncology and 21 quilts to the VA Clinic in Calcutta.....FANTASTIC!!! We had a VERY productive first year, and I look forward to completing and donating even more quilts in 2011!!! Barb Cascioli was a great help to us getting started!! We had LOTS of help cutting, kitting, sewing, quilting and finishing the quilts; and I thank you all!!! We sincerely appreciate the generous donation we received from the guild to purchase fleece, and we

were overwhelmed with loads of quilt top fabric!!! We're still doing well with the quilt top fabric, but we are definitely in need of fleece!!! Each quilt takes 1 1/4 yards of 60" fleece, and we can always use navy and brighter colors (for the oncology quilts). Thanks for all your help in terms of material things AND "sweat equity" you have graciously donated to this project! We completed 49 quilts in 2010. I challenge you to work toward completing and donating 75 charity quilts in 2011!!! That's only 26 more quilts than we completed in 2010! That means we have to make at least 7 quilts a month!!!
