UFO Challenge

Several members presented their UFO projects at the April meeting. Some were years in the making (or not making) and others more recent. If you did not bring a project there is still time. You may bring your project to future meetings. Pat Firestone provided a signup sheet for the UFO projects so we have record of your goal.

The UFO might be a block of the month that never was finished or possibly a quilt that you were anxious to try a new technique and set aside to start something else or a workshop project that you never got back to. You must commit to a goal, such as 1) finish piecing top, 2) add borders, quilt and bind or 3) quilt and bind. Then in September bring back the finished project to show. Everyone who accomplishes their committed goal will be given a chance to win a \$25 gift certificate to a fabric shop.

Spring Tea

We need to have an 18x24 cutting board, rotary cutter, 18" or longer ruler, pencil, red marker, scissors, 90 pins, about 5 ironing stations with ironing surfaces, NO SEWING MACHINE!!
- 3) We'll have cold water, hot water for tea, coffee. Bring your own pop, etc. We'll have some munchies -
