The June 5, 2015 meeting opened at 6:30 with a trunk show/ demo of stack 'n wack quilts by Sandy Lord, owner of The Gallery in PA. She showed a variety of stack 'n wack quilts. She started with a 4 patch stack of four layers of fabric. She suggested 1) Never wash your fabric and 2) Never use a batik for stack 'n wack. Striped fabrics make unique patterns. She went on to explain 6 layers of fabric create hexagons and 8 layers creates octogons. She showed a fan design. She announced a sale June 25,26,27, 2015 after she has been to Market Review.

In the absence of Dee Hart and Debbie Mangas, Mary Durkin conducted the business part of the meeting with 41 members present.
